



## APPLICATION FOR SENIOR'S PROPERTY TAX REBATE BY-LAW 2024-048

### How to Apply:

- Annual applications are required and must be received on or before October 31 in the year for which the application is for
- Applications must be in writing by completing the attached application form and returned annually to the Town of Oakville, ATTN to Revenue Services and Tax, Finance
- An annual application **MUST** include a copy of a Notice of Assessment prepared by Canada Revenue Agency from the year prior to the year in which the application is made (e.g. Notice from 2023 for the 2024 application year), showing line 15000, for all registered owners on title
  - The income threshold for 2024 is **\$35,252**
  - Copy of CRA Notice of Assessment will be destroyed after income threshold verification by the Town of Oakville
- For first time applicants, the application **MUST** include a copy of proof of age of sixty-five (65)
  - Applicants who have participated in the program in past years do not need to provide further proof of age once verified by the Town of Oakville
  - Copy of proof of age will be destroyed after verified by the Town of Oakville
- The applicant may not have any outstanding property taxes on account as of October 1<sup>st</sup> of the year the application is received by the Town of Oakville

This general information page is provided for convenience only. Applicants may review by-law 2024-048 for full text of the program requirements. The by-law governs the operation of the rebate program, and the eligibility and application requirements.
