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York Street and Wallace Road Reconstruction

May 14, 2024: Status Update

Dear Tenant/Business Owner,

As communicated in previous correspondence, the town will be making improvements on York Street from Speers Road to Wallace Road, and on Wallace Road, from Speers Road to the end of the Wallace Road cul-de-sac. We are applying final adjustments to the detailed design of York Street and Wallace Road Reconstruction. Construction is expected to begin late summer/fall of 2024, after utility relocations.

Oakville Hydro will relocate the existing pole line at York and Wallace, south of Speers Road, commencing May 21, 2024. Pole relocation will last five to seven weeks, weather depending.

All hydro pole relocation work is occurring within the limits of the public roadway. Tenants/Business owners are asked to move their vehicles out of the right of way and provide ample space for hydro pole relocation and construction works.

Please direct your questions pertaining to Oakville Hydro Works to Oakville Hydro representatives indicated on their notification letter.

Town surveyors will be in the area to identify and re-mark the limits of the public right of way and the Full Construction Plan can be viewed on the York Street and Wallace Road Reconstruction town website, and is on the back of this page.

Road reconstruction is estimated to begin late summer/fall of 2024 and will take six to eight months to complete. Project completion is estimated for 2025.

Traffic on Wallace Road and York Street will remain open during construction but may be reduced to one lane at times in select areas. Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
